

METCHOSIN COMMUNITY HALL COMMUNICABLE DISEASE SAFETY PLAN

June 22, 2022

COVID-specific safety measures:

1. Renters/event organizers must follow any current verbal or written BC Public Health Office (PHO) Orders and Guidance
2. Event organizers and participants must follow current federal travel advisories (including any requirements for isolation or masking in public places following arrival)
3. Event organizers can choose to require masks on the premises
4. No one should enter the Hall if they have symptoms of a communicable disease (for example, fever and/or chills, recent onset of coughing, diarrhea) or have had a recent positive COVID test
5. Event organizers are encouraged to improve building ventilation by opening windows and/or doors, weather-permitting (and thanks for closing windows and doors on departure)
6. Hand hygiene is encouraged – sanitize/wash your hands regularly and cover coughs and sneezes with your arm
7. Help us maintain a clean environment at the Hall

Other Public Health Officer (PHO) COVID Safety guidance:

- Individuals may choose to wear masks to reduce risk
- Outdoor gatherings are safer than indoor
- People at higher risk (e.g. age, health status) may choose to reduce social interactions
